3. Results against teams not in playoffs from highest finish to lowest finish
4. Coin toss

Policy for Inclement Weather

If the tournament is not played; the highest seed would receive the AQ. All games should be completed. If a game(s) is halted, it should be continued at the spot where it was halted as per the NCAA rule book concerning halted games. All tournament games need to be completed by the NCAA deadline for NCAA tournament selection.

If the tournament is started, but cannot be completed:

- 0 games played = highest seed
- 1 games played = highest seed
- 2 games played = highest seed
- 3 games played = highest remaining seed
- 4 games played = highest remaining seed
- 5 games played = highest remaining seed
- 6 games played = winner of game 6
- 7 games played = winner of game 7
