

2007 MIAC Men's Outdoor Track & Field Awards

Saint John's University junior **Chris Erichsen** (Spring Valley, Minn./Kingsland) was selected MIAC Men's Outstanding Track Athlete after he won the 1,500 and 5,000 meter runs at the 2007 MIAC Outdoor Track & Field Championships held this past weekend. Erichsen's time of 3:56.96 in the 1,500 set a new Clemen's Stadium record. In the 5,000 meter run, Erichsen won the race with a time of 14:58.98.

Saint John's University junior **Erik Diley** (Prescott, Wis.) was chosen MIAC Men's Outstanding Field Athlete for his performance at the 2007 Outdoor Championships. Diley won the long jump with a mark of 23'4.75" (7.13m). His leap provisionally qualified him for the NCAA Championships and set a new stadium record. Diley also finished second in the triple jump with a NCAA provisional jump of 46'8.75" (14.24m).

Gustavus Adolphus College senior **Tanner Miest** (New London, Minn./New London-Spicer) earned the honor of MIAC Men's Outstanding Performance as he three-peated as MIAC Champion in the 110 meter hurdles with a stadium record and NCAA provisional qualifying time of 14.58 seconds.

Tim **Miles** of Saint John's University was selected men's MIAC Outdoor Coach of the Year. Miles guided Saint John's to there fourth MIAC Outdoor team championship in 11 years.
