

2002 MIAC Men's Soccer Athletes of the Week

November 11, 2002

Macalester College midfielder Andrew Wissler (FY, Annandale, VA / Woodson H.S.) picked up assists on both Macalester second half goals Friday (Nov. 8) in a 2-0 win over Saint Mary's as the Scots finished off their second straight unbeaten MIAC season. Macalester will travel to Luther this weekend to play in the NCAA Tournament for the sixth time in the past seven seasons.

November 4, 2002

Saint Mary's University forward Brian Reddish (Sophomore, Crystal Lake, IL, Crystal Lake South HS) scored two goals in the first 90 seconds of the game against Bethel on Saturday. Reddish's two goals held up as the Cardinals defeated Bethel by a score of 2-1. Reddish now has 3 goals and 3 assists in conference play.

October 28, 2002

Saint John's University midfielder Mike Rutter (Sr., Apple Valley, Minn.) had a goal and an assist in St. John's only game this week, a 3-1 win over St. Mary's. Rutter assisted on the game-tying goal in the first half and then scored the game-winner eight minutes later. The victory moves St. John's into third place in the league. The Johnnies are now 4-2-2 in the MIAC and 10-4-2 overall.

October 21, 2002

Hamline University goalkeeper Brain Lawson (First-year, Gig Harbor, Wash/Peninsula HS) played three stellar games last week for the Pipers that increased their winning streak to six games. Lawson shut out Augsburg, 1-0, on Wednesday making nine saves. It was his fourth shutout in a row. That streak was stopped by Northwestern College on Friday, but he earned the victory, 2-1. It was the first goal scored against Lawson in more than 369 minutes. Lawson stopped six shots in the contest. Saturday, Lawson earned his third win of the week in the Pipers' 5-0 win over UW-Superior.

October 14, 2002

Hamline University forward Spencer Iverson (Junior, Maple Grove, Minn.) scored the game-winner in the Pipers' 1-0 win at Concordia Saturday afternoon in Moorhead, Minn. Iverson stole the ball from a defender and went in for the breakaway goal at the 5:04 mark of the first half. Iverson also had an assist in the team's 2-0 win over Crown College on Tuesday.

October 7, 2002

Macalester College sophomore forward Brendan Viele (Shoreview, MN / Mounds View) scored an insurance goal in the 78th minute to help the Scots beat St. John's 2-0 Tuesday (Oct. 1) in Collegeville. Viele scored twice Friday (Oct. 4) in Macalester's 2-0 victory over Bethel, his fifth and sixth of the season.

September 30, 2002

Carleton College first-year forward David Watson (Woodbury, Minn.) scored two goals as Carleton notched its first MIAC win of the season, beating Bethel 2-0 in its lone game of the week. Watson's first goal was electrifying, as he blasted home a shot from 20 yards out into the upper corner of the net. His second tally came on a breakaway, as he chipped the ball over the charging Bethel keeper. It marked Watson's first multi-goal game of his career.

September 23, 2002

Bethel College senior forward Pepe Jon Chavez (Lima, Peru), scored three goals and added an assist in Bethel's 6-1 win over Augsburg on Saturday. Playing with a torn groin muscle, Chavez has scored 5 goals and added 4 assists this season.
