Gustavus Adolphus College first-year **Katie Schenfeld** (Indianola, Iowa) shot an 81, which was the low round at LeSueur Country Club on Saturday, in a meet that included Gustavus, UW-Stevens Point and two individuals from Macalester. As a team, Gustavus defeated UW-Stevens Point 336-355.

Laura Knutson, Carleton

Carleton College first-year **Laura Knutson** (Edina, Minn.) fired a six-over par 79 to finish third, and first among MIAC players, at the weather-shortened UW-Eau Claire Spring Invitational. In a field with two NCAA Championships automatic qualifying teams and at least two individuals that will make it as well, Knutson capped off the best rookie season in Carleton history with her third top-five finish of the season. The round allowed her to finish with a new freshman school single-season scoring mark of 85.1. Her score helped Carleton fire a 343, a 19-shot improvement over Carleton's season-opening round at Wild Ridge Golf Club back in September, and allowed the Knights to finish fourth behind second-ranked St. Thomas, fourth-ranked UW-Stevens Point and 16th-ranked UW-Eau Claire. The Knights were only three back of the BluGolds and eight behind the Pointers.

Kali Griggs, Gustavus

Gustavus Adolphus College sophomore **Kali Griggs** (Burnsville, Minn./Visitation) finished first with a 36-hole total of 76-73--149 at the Minnesota Women's Collegiate Golf Association Invitational (MWCGA) at Pebble Creek Golf Club in Becker, Minnesota. Gustavus, ranked third in the nation, topped second place St. Thomas by 41 strokes and scored a 18-hole total of 297 on Sunday which set a new school record.

University of St. Thomas sophomore **Laura Heck** (Chisholm, Minn./Hibbing) won medalist honors to lead the No. 3-ranked St. Thomas women's golf squad to first place out of six teams at Sunday's Carleton Spring Invite. The two-day, 36-hole tournament was cut to a one-day, 18-hole competition due to weather. For Heck, it was her fourth consecutive strong performance dating back to last fall, when she was the MIAC meet medalist and co-medalist at the Midwest Classic. She also took fifth out of 142 players in March at the Jekyll Island tourney.

Gustavus Adolphus College senior **Rachel Roberg** (Rice Lake, Wis.) shot 80-80 to finish in fourth place at the Wartburg Invitational at Centennial Golf Course, site of the 2008 NCAA Women's Golf Championships, in Waverly, Iowa on Sunday. Roberg and the Gusties won the tournament with a two-day total of 329-319--648, which was 18 strokes ahead of second-place finisher Illinois Wesleyan.

Laura Heck, St. Thomas

University of St. Thomas sophomore **Laura Heck** (Chisholm, Minn./Hibbing) walked away with medalist honors at the 2007 MIAC Women's Golf Championship at Bunker Hills Golf Course in Coon Rapids. She posted rounds of 76, 77 and 77 for a 230, just two shots off the MIAC Championship 54-hole record score of 228 set in 2006 by teammate Holly Noble. Heck helped the Tommies to an unprecedented seventh consecutive MIAC team title and an automatic berth into the May 2008 Division III National Tournament.
