Gustavus Adolphus College junior **Katie Schenfeld** (Indianola, Iowa) claimed medalist honors for the third time this spring, and fifth time this season, at the UW-Eau Claire Invitational at Wild Ridge Golf Course in Eau Claire. Schenfeld fired rounds of 77 and 76 to win the individual title by two strokes with her 36-hole total of 153. The #2-ranked Gusties finished off a dominating spring regular season by winning the event by 20 strokes.

As a team, Gustavus rallied in the final round with a tournament record 313 to win the invite with a 36-hole total of 326-313-639.

As a team, the #2 ranked Gusties posted a 36-hole team score of 620 to finish 26 strokes ahead of second place UW-Eau Claire, which is ranked #3 nationally.

In the first tournament of the spring season, Gustavus won the 13-team invite with a 36-hole total of 610, the second lowest total in program history.

Drenttel's individual rounds of 74 and 75 are the best two 18 hole rounds of her collegiate career and her 36-hole total of 149 is the finest 36-hole total in her career. Gustavus won the 13-team invite with a 36-hole total of a 610. The Gusties' 36-hole total is the second best in program history and was achieved in the team's first tournament of the spring season.

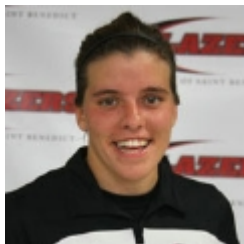

Her 75 at Mill Run on Saturday featured three consecutive birdies on the back nine. Hauff's score was the low score for all MIAC schools in the field, including Team Champion Gustavus, Carleton, Saint Thomas, Saint Mary's and Augsburg.
