

Lisa Bauer, Macalester

Week of: 2003-11-12

Macalester College senior goalkeeper Lisa Bauer (Woodbury, Minn.) recorded two shutouts in the MIAC Playoffs this past week helping the Scots win the MIAC Playoff Championship. Bauer made five saves in the semifinal 5-0 victory over St. Thomas on Tuesday. In the MIAC Championship game on Saturday, Bauer recorded two saves in regulation play and saved three penalty shots to lift the Scots past regular season champion College of Saint Benedict. Macalester plays at UW-Stevens Point in the first round of the NCAA Tournament Wednesday.

Megan McVoy, Saint Benedict

College of Saint Benedict junior forward Megan McVoy (Omaha, NE...Duchesne Academy) scored the winning goal at Concordia this past weekend which helped CSB clinch the MIAC championship. McVoy added a goal and an assist in a 6-0 victory over Bethel. She now leads the conference with 15 goals and 7 assists.

Heidi Hilleren, Augsburg

Augsburg College senior midfielder Heidi Hilleren (Duluth, Minn./East HS) scored two key goals for the Auggies this past week. Against MIAC rival Carleton, Hilleren scored in a crucial 2-2 tie. Sunday against Elmhurst, she scored the game winning goal in the 64th minute on a 25 yard shot giving the Auggies a 1-0 victory. With the victory and tie, Augsburg improved to 10-5-2 overall, reaching double-digits in victories for the second year in a row and just the fifth time in the 19-season history of Augsburg womens soccer.

Tae Ruppe, Saint Benedict

College of Saint Benedict senior goalkeeper Tae Ruppe (Forest Lake, Minn.) had two shutouts this week against Augsburg and Macalester. Ruppe was credited with three saves against the Auggies and seven versus the Scots. She was a key factor in the Macalester win, not only in the saves department, but fended off 14 corners. Ruppe leads the conference in shutouts with 8 and has a top GAA of 0.19.

Emily Strom, Saint Mary's

Saint Marys University senior goalkeeper Emily Strom (Waterford, Wis. / Union HS) made 8 saves and cut out numerous scoring threats from Bethel as SMU picked up its first MIAC win of the season. The Cardinals beat the Royal 3-0 and broke a 16 game MIAC losing streak. Strom earned her first shutout of the season in the victory.

Morgan Bain, Concordia

Concordia College freshman Morgan Bain (Hugo, Minn. / White Bear Lake HS) scored the game winning goal against Macalester and added 2 more against Saint Marys to lead the conference leading Cobbers at the mid-way point in MIAC play.

Christine Williams, St. Thomas

University of St. Thomas sophomore forward Christine Williams (Burnsville, Minn.) scored a hat trick against Carleton and recorded an assist against St. Olaf in two MIAC victories this week. The Tommies improved to a perfect 3-0 in conference play and 5-3-1 overall.

Suzy Grabko, Concordia

Suzy Grabko, Concordia College (Fr., Midfielder, Fargo, N.Dak./Fargo North HS) had a goal and two assists in Concordias two MIAC wins last week. In the Cobbers first win of the week, Grabko had a goal and an assist in Concordias 2-0 win at Bethel. Against Gustavus, Grabko struck a deadball that led to the game-winning goal in overtime. On the play, she fired a shot that the Gustavus goalie made a diving stop and Concordia was able to poke home the rebound. It was the first time since 1989 that Concordia had beaten Gustavus. Concordia is now 2-0 in the MIAC this season, the last time the Cobbers started league play with two wins was back in 1990.
