# Augsburg's Irving headlines 2016 MIAC Women's Cross Country Awards

BLOOMINGTON, Minn. – The 2016 Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAC) Women's Cross Country Championships were held Saturday at Como Golf Course in St. Paul, Minn., and Thursday the top performers from another outstanding MIAC meet were recognized with the announcement of the 2016 MIAC Women's Cross Country Awards, with the meet's champions taking home top honors.

Augsburg College senior Taybri Irving (Rosemount, Minn.) was named the 2016 MIAC Women's Cross Country Athlete-of-the-Year after her first-place finish at the MIAC meet, and University of St. Thomas Head Coach Joe Sweeney was voted the 2016 MIAC Women's Cross Country Coach-of-the-Year by his peers in recognition of his work in guiding the Tommies to the MIAC team championship. All-Conference, Honorable Mention and All-Sportsmanship Teams were also recognized.

Irving made history Saturday when she became Augsburg's first-ever individual champion, and that history continued Thursday with her Athlete-of-the-Year award. The senior star completed the 6k course in 22:32.5. Irving averaged 6:02.6 per mile and 3:45.4 per kilometer, and defeated defending champion Kimber Meyer of Macalester by nearly 10 seconds.

The individual championship and MIAC honor represents tremendous improvement throughout Irving's career.

She finished 65th and 42nd at the MIAC Championships as a first-year and sophomore, respectively, before moving all the way up to seventh in 2015, and she completed her ascent to the top of the leader board in 2016. In addition, Irving received her second-straight All-Conference honor to headline that squad.

Sweeney – in his 37th season – was voted Coach-of-the-Year for his team's impressive first-place performance. The Tommies put four runners in the top 12 and all five who scored finished in the top 20, to give the team a winning total of 50 points. This is the 16th overall MIAC women's cross country championship for the Tommies – the most in conference history – but just the first since 2008 for Sweeney's club. The title comes on the heels of an NCAA Central Region championship a year ago, which St. Thomas will try to defend later this month.

The veteran coach guided four UST runners to All-Conference honors and two more to Honorable Mention accolades at Saturday's championship race. During his career, Sweeney has won numerous MIAC Coach-of-the-Year awards in cross country and indoor and outdoor track and field, but the 2016 award is his first in cross country since 2007.

In addition to the top individual honors, the MIAC Women's Cross Country All-Conference and All-Conference Honorable mention squads were also recognized. The top 15 finishers in Saturday's MIAC Championship race received All-Conference honors, while finishers 16-25 received Honorable Mention. Champion St. Thomas led the way with four All-Conference runners. Carleton and Saint Benedict had three apiece, St. Olaf had two and Augsburg and St. Catherine each had one. The team featured 10 seniors, two juniors, two sophomores and one first-year runner.

As part of a conference-wide sportsmanship initiative, the MIAC announced the 11th annual All-MIAC Sportsmanship team for Women's Cross Country. Members of the All-MIAC Sportsmanship team are selected by their coaches and teammates as individuals who demonstrate ideals of positive sportsmanship both on and off the field of competition.
