

THREE TOMS ON AP COACHES

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There evidently was a wealth of good football players around the Minnesota college conference this fall, judging by the votes of the league's eight coaches in selecting their annual all-star football team.

In fact there were so many strong players in the league that selection of an all-star team doubtless results in considerable injustice to many athletes not winning places.

The poll of coaches, conducted by the Associated Press, found St. Thomas college, the champion, being allotted three places; St. Mary's college of Winona, the runnerup, two; Macalester college, in third place, one; Gustavus Adolphus, two; St. John's and Hamline universities, and Concordia college of Moorhead, one each.

Coaches liked several members of the St. Olaf college eleven, only school NOT to win a position on the first eleven, but votes for those players were spread out without enough concentration on one to permit a position. Two St. Olaf athletes, however, won places on the second team.

Nominated to honorary positions as co-captains of the mythical eleven are Frank Zukaitis of St. Thomas college and Russell Buckley of Gustavus Adolphus, the only two players to win maximum vote totals in their positions at right end and quarterback, respectively.

Zukaitis and Buckley, both seniors, are also on the all-state

eleven for the second straight year, along with Jim Roche, the St. John's University speedster, who is placed at left half.

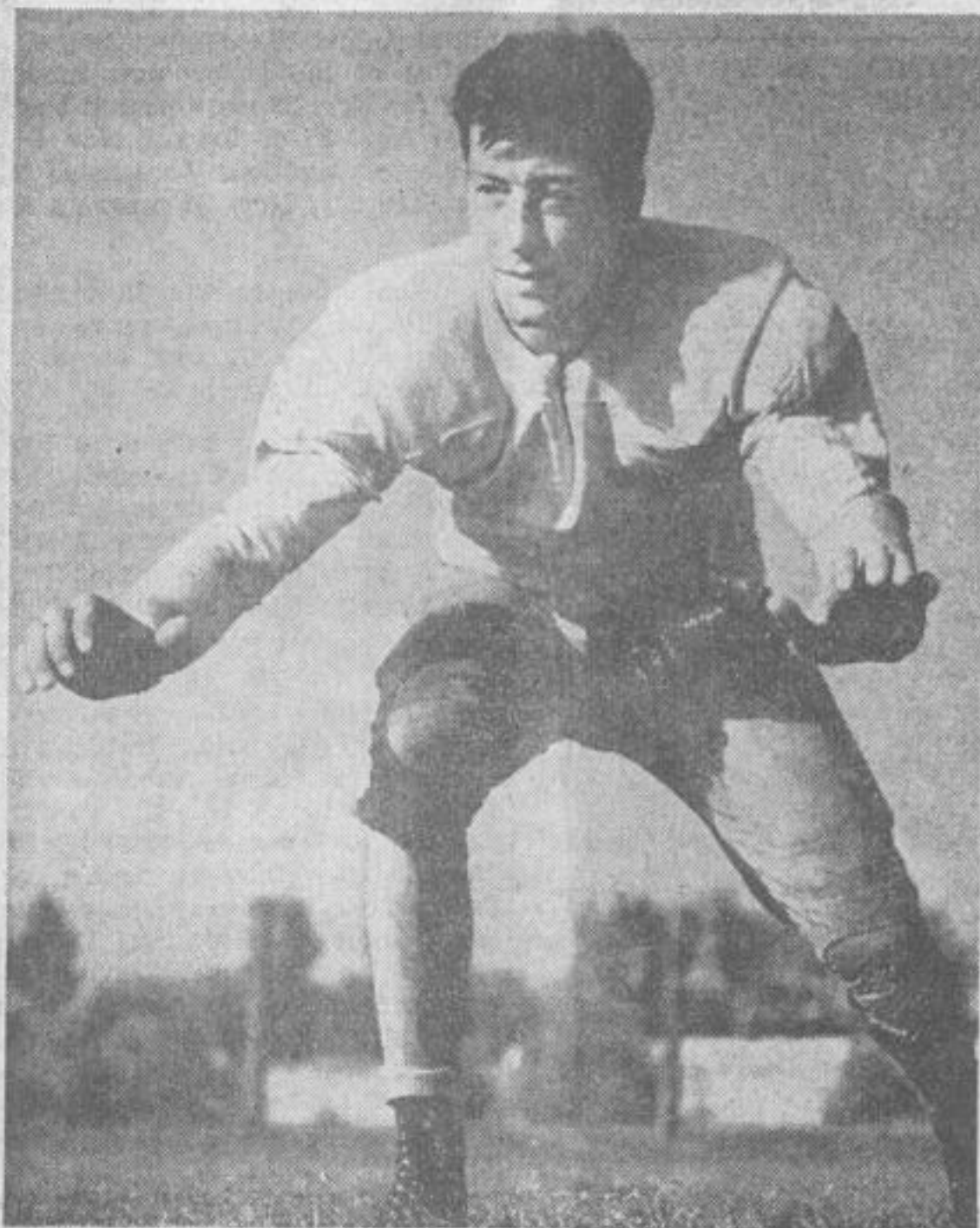
