
MIAC basketball teams set to return to the court



BLOOMINGTON, Minn. – Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAC) men's and women's basketball teams will return to the court for the first time since March this weekend.

Both the MIAC men's and women's basketball schedules will feature eight teams in conference competition this winter. Squads from Augsburg, Bethel, Concordia, Gustavus, Hamline, Saint Benedict/Saint John's, Saint Mary's, and St. Thomas will participate in a seven-game conference slate, set to begin on Saturday, February 6. Teams are also permitted to play up to four non-conference contests, with games getting underway as early as this Friday, January 29.
