

## **Andrew Longbella, Saint John's**

Week of: 2007-05-01

Saint John's University senior Andrew Longbella (Chippewa Falls, Wis./McDonnell) shot a 1 under par 71 in a dual against Saint Cloud State last Thursday at the Saint Cloud Country Club, and followed it up with a 4 under par 67 in a dual with Gustavus on Sunday at the Monticello CC.

## **Joe Schoolmeesters, Saint John's**

Saint John's University sophomore Joe Schoolmeesters (Litchfield, Minn.) recorded rounds of 69 and 69 for a six under par total of 138 at the Saint John's Spring Invitational Sunday April 22. The total helped Schoolmeesters to win medalist honors and lead the Johnnies to a victory in the event.

## **Erik Helgerson, Augsburg**

Augsburg College senior Erik Helgerson (Chisago City, Minn./Chisago Lakes) finished second individually among 120 players with a score of two under par 142 at the Buena Vista Spring Invitational in Storm Lake, Iowa. He led the Auggies to a third place finish in the event with a team score of 593.

## **Erik Helgerson, Augsburg**

Augsburg College senior Erik Helgerson (Chisago City, Minn./Chisago Lakes) shot a 2-over-par 73 at the Loras Spring Invitational and finished seventh overall. Helgerson had the best score of any MIAC player in the tournament. He also was medalist in a tri-match against Chandler Gilbert Community College and Buena Vista (Iowa) in Arizona with a 74.

## **Jonathon Northrad, Concordia**

Concordia College junior Jonathon Northrad (Grand Rapids, Minn.) tied for third with a three-day total of 227 at the Twins Cities Classic and was the highest conference finisher at the meet. Northrad fired a 71 on Saturday at Elk River CC, then shot another 71 at North Fork in Ramsey on Sunday and finished the tournament with a 85 at Hazeltine National on Monday.

## **Joe Schoolmeesters, Saint John's**

Saint John's University sophomore Joe Schoolmeesters (Litchfield, Minn.) led the MIAC Championship after each day and finished with a 72

on Monday to post a two-under-par 214 to claim top individual honors at the 54-hole, MIAC Men's Golf Championship held at Bunker Hills Golf Course in Coon Rapids. Schoolmeesters helped Saint John's claim their third straight MIAC title. With the win, the Johnnies earn an automatic bid to the 2007 NCAA Championship.

## **Joe Schoolmeesters, Saint John's**

Saint John's University sophomore Joe Schoolmeesters (Litchfield, Minn.) finished fourth at the Frank Wigglesworth Bluegold Collegiate in Eau Claire, Wis. this past weekend, the highest finish of any MIAC golfer, he finished with a 71-75=146. ## **Drew Dvorak, Concordia**

Concordia College junior Drew Dvorak (Litchfield, Minn.) shot 221 (74-74-73) to finish runner-up at the Erv Kaiser Invite to Eric Johnson of North Dakota State. Dvorak was paired with Johnson on Day One and Day Three as the Cobbers were in the final grouping all three days. Dvorak led the Cobbers to 304 at Oxbow Country Club in very windy conditions on Friday, 297 at Village Green on Saturday, and 302 at the Fargo Country Club on Sunday. Concordia's three-day total of 903 was good for third in the 13-team field.

Saint John's University sophomore Joe Schoolmeesters (Litchfield, Minn.) captured his first collegiate title at the 17-team Bemidji State Invitational this weekend.
