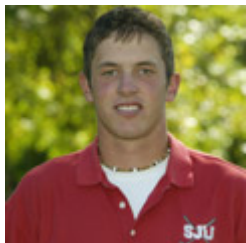

Alec Roman, Carleton

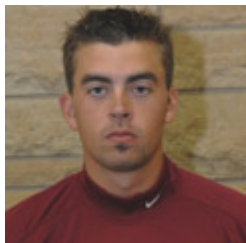

Drew Dvorak, Concordia

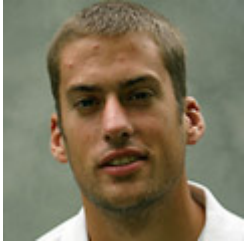
