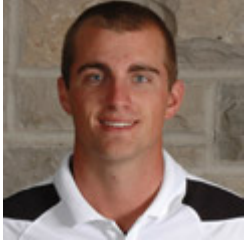


Bror Herrick, St. Olaf

Week of: 2009-05-04



St. Olaf College senior **Bror Herrick** (Golden Valley, Minn./Minnehaha Academy) shot a final round 74 (+2) at Willinger's Golf Club on Sunday to finish with a two-day 149 (+5) and share the individual title at the St. Olaf Invitational. Herrick fired a 75 during the event's first day at Northfield Golf Club and came from three strokes behind to share the tournament's win with Saint John's Joe Daly. St. Olaf was just 21 strokes off defending national champion Saint John's winning pace and 10 behind second place Bethel.

Saint John's University senior **Joe Daly** (Owatonna, Minn.) tied for medalist honors with a two-day total of 149 (+5) at the St. Olaf Invitational. Daly's score included a one-under par 71 on Sunday. Daly helped No. 7 Saint John's erase a nine-stroke deficit to win the event.

Woodhull was awarded medalist honors by virtue of a tiebreaker. As a team, Gustavus finished fourth out of 17 teams.

Jeff Nechas, Saint John's

Saint John's University senior **Jeff Nechas** (Otsego, Minn./Wayzata) fired a 221 (+9) with rounds of 71, 77, and 73 in brutal weather conditions at the Bobby Krig Invitational hosted by Gustavus. Nechas was the top MIAC finisher and placed tied for second overall.

Ricky Copeland, Gustavus

Gustavus Adolphus College junior **Ricky Copeland** (Mahtomedi, Minn.) fired rounds of 74-70 to lead the Gusties to a fourth place finish in the Wartburg Invitational. Copeland was the highest placing MIAC competitor as he finished fourth out of 91 golfers with his two-day score of even-par 144. Copeland's total of 70 was the low round of day two.

Ricky Copeland, Gustavus

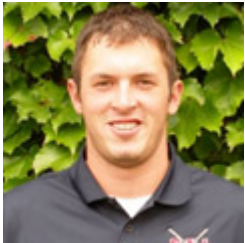

Copeland's total of 147 led Gustavus to an eighth-place finish (302-320--622) in the 22-team invitational.

Joe Schoolmeesters, Saint John's

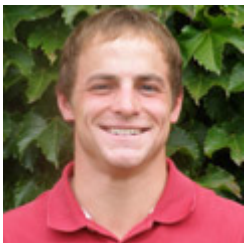

Saint John's University senior **Joe Schoolmeesters** (Litchfield, Minn.) led the Johnnies to their fourth MIAC Men's Golf Championship in the last five years on Monday, Oct. 6. He claimed medalist honors for the second time in his career with three-day total of 218 (+2). Schoolmeesters led all individuals as a sophomore at the 2006 MIAC Championship. Saint John's finished with a three-day team total of 889 (+25). The 2008 MIAC Golf Championships were held October 4-6 at Bunker Hills Golf Course in Coon Rapids, Minn.

Joe Daly, Saint John's

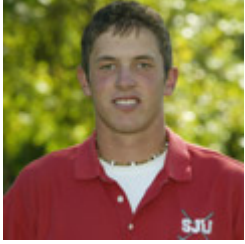

Saint John's University senior **Joe Daly** (Owatonna, Minn.) fired a one-under-par three-day total of 215 to finish second at the Twin Cities Classic out of 117 golfers. He shot 69-73-73 at Elk River Country Club, the Links at Northfork, and the White Bear Yacht Club on Saturday, Sunday, and Monday, respectively. Daly's finish was the highest of any MIAC player and helped the Johnnies finish second to Illinois Wesleyan. Daly enters this weekend's MIAC Championships with a 72.5 scoring average, good for second in the conference.

Joe Schoolmeesters, Saint John's

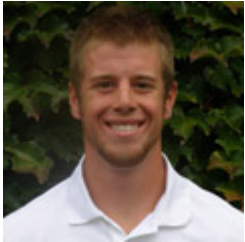

Saint John's University senior **Joe Schoolmeesters** (Litchfield, Minn.) led his team to a win at the Frank Wigglesworth Bluegold Collegiate, firing a three-over-par 145 over the weekend. Schoolmeesters finished second individually in the meet held in Eau Claire, Wis. and was the top Division III and MIAC golfer. He shot the low round of the tournament with a 69 on Sunday.

Alex Wieme, Saint John's

Saint John's University senior **Alex Wieme** (Sartell, Minn./Sartell-St. Stephen) earned medalist honors with a three-under par 69 to lead Saint John's Blue to a six-stroke victory at the annual Saint John's Fall Invitational Sunday, Sept. 14 at Blackberry Ridge G.C. in Sartell. The first round of the tournament was cancelled due to excessive rain Saturday, reducing the invite to just 18 holes Sunday. This is Wieme's first collegiate tournament victory.

Mason Swenson, Bethel

Bethel University first-year **Mason Swenson** (Eagan, Minn.) was the medalist at the Augsburg Invitational, leading Bethel to a first place finish for the first time in more than 10 years. Swenson fired a 3-under par 69 at Oakdale Golf Club on Saturday getting Bethel off to a great start for the weekend. In tougher course conditions on Sunday, he recorded a 77 (6 over par) at Crow River to contribute to Bethel's tournament victory. Bethel was the only team in the 12-school, 17-team field to finish under the 600-stroke barrier in the team standings with a 597 (289-308) finish.
