

Jeff Doll, Saint John's

Week of: 2007-05-08

Track & Field - Saint John's University senior Jeff Doll (Farmington, Minn.) provisionally qualified for the NCAA Championships by winning the MIAC Decathlon this past weekend with a total of 6299 points. His performance and points for each of the ten events were: 100 Meter Dash - 11.56 (740 points); Long Jump - 20-5 1/4 (6.23m) (637 points); Shot Put - 33-8 (10.26m) (501 points); High Jump - 5-10 (1.78m) (610 points); 400 Meter Dash - 50.00 (815 points); 110 Meter Hurdles - 16.23 (707 points); Discus Throw - 100-9 (30.71m) (478 points); Pole Vault - 13-5 1/4 (4.10m) (645 points); Javelin Throw - 126-1 (38.43m) (419 points); 1500 Meter Run - 4:29.71 (747 points)

Andrew Yokom, Macalester

Week of: 2007-05-01

Track - Macalester College sophomore Andrew Yokom (Arden Hills, Minn./Mounds View) qualified provisionally for the NCAA Championships in the 400m hurdles with a time of 53.92 at the Bolstorff Twilight hosted by Macalester College. The performance currently ranks him eighth in Division III.

Tanner Miest, Gustavus

Week of: 2007-04-24

Track - Gustavus Adolphus College senior Tanner Miest (Willmar, Minn.) won the 110m hurdles at the Carleton Relays in a NCAA provisional qualifying time of 14.84 on Saturday, April 21. He is currently ranked ninth in NCAA Division III.

Chris Erichsen, Saint John's

Week of: 2007-04-17

Track - Saint John's University junior Chris Erichsen (Spring Valley, Minn./Kingsland) qualified automatically in the 3000m steeplechase with a time of 9:05.84 at the Meet of Saints hosted by St. Olaf College. The performance currently ranks him first in NCAA Division III.

Travis Bristow, Hamline

Week of: 2007-04-03

Track - Hamline University senior Travis Bristow (Pine River, Minn./Pine River-Backus) ran a 14:35.56 in the 5000 meters at Missouri Relays on Friday night. The time is a NCAA provisional qualifying time and also the top time in the NCAA thus far. His time also sets a new Hamline school record.

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Drew Hood, Gustavus

Week of: 2007-05-01

Field - Gustavus Adolphus College junior Drew Hood (Mankato, Minn./West) qualified provisionally for the NCAA Championships in the pole vault with a height of 15' 5" at the Drake Alternative meet hosted by Gustavus Adolphus College. He is currently ranked 20th in Division III.

Lucas Blodgett, Bethel

Week of: 2007-04-24

Field - Bethel University sophomore Lucas Blodgett (Spring Valley, Wis.) qualified provisionally for the NCAA Championships in the hammer throw with a toss of 53.00m at the Carleton Relays. The mark was a school record and ranks him 12th in Division III. Blodgett also threw a personal best in the discus of 42.16m good for fourth place on Saturday.

Andy Klaers, Gustavus

Week of: 2007-04-17

Field - Gustavus Adolphus College senior Andy Klaers (Loretto, Minn./Delano) provisionally qualified for the NCAA championships in the discus with a winning throw of 160-6 at the Lee Krough Invite held Saturday in St. Peter. Klaers also won the hammer throw (159-6) and finished sixth in the shot put (41-6 1/2).
