Gustavus Adolphus College senior **Max Hanson** (Buffalo, Minn.) took advantage of strong competition, and despite cooler temperatures and gusty winds, won the 800 meter race in an NCAA Automatic Qualifying time of 1:50.31 at Hamline's Meet of the UnSaintly. Hanson is currently ranked second in the nation and first in the MIAC with his 800 time. Later in the meet, Hanson came back in the 4x400 meter relay to run a 47.2 split.

Taylor Ferda, Bethel

Bethel University senior **Taylor Ferda** (Whitefish, Mont.) overcame gusty winds and stiff competition to win the 110-meter hurdles at the Howard Wood Dakota Relays in a NCAA automatic-qualifying time of 14.41 seconds. His time ranks him first in the MIAC and tied for second in Division III this season.

4 x 400 Meter Relay Team, Gustavus

The **Gustavus Adolphus College 4 x 400 Meter Relay Team** of Matt Leeb (Jr., St. Peter, Minn.), Cole Carlson (Sr., Mora, Minn.), Colby Citrowski (Jr., Canby, Minn.), and Max Hanson (Sr., Buffalo, Minn.) automatically qualified for the NCAA Championships with a time of 3:12.88, good for seventh place at the prestigious Drake Relays on Saturday. The time is the best in the MIAC and second fastest in Division III this season.

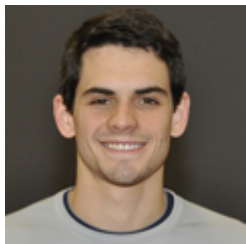

Brennan McKeag, Hamline

Hamline University sophomore **Brennan McKeag** (Lakeville, Minn./Apple Valley) won the shot put competition at the Capitol City Championships by almost two meters with his toss of 16.53 meters (54-2 3/4). McKeag's distance is second best in the MIAC and 12th in Division III this season.

Gustavus Adolphus College senior **Brian Anderson** (Minneapolis, Minn./Bloomington Kennedy) hit NCAA provisional marks in the shot put and hammer throw during the Drake Alternative at Gustavus on Saturday. Anderson was the top Division III competitor in the two events as he placed fourth in the shot put with a distance of 15.56 meters and fifth in the hammer throw with a mark of 54.38 meters. His hammer throw ranks second in the MIAC and his shot put distance ranks fourth in the conference.

Brennan McKeag, Hamline
