2002-03 MIAC Men's Swimming & Diving Athletes of the Week

February 4, 2003

St. Olaf College first-year **Mark Glineburg** (St. Paul, Minn. / Cretin Derham Hall) was a triple winner in leading St. Olaf in victory over St. Thomas this past weekend. Glineburg's time in the 200 free was 1:48.68, in the 200 fly, he went 2:02.04, and he finished with the 200 breast in a time of 2:17.92.

January 28, 2003

Gustavus Adolphus College senior **Chris Kramer** (Forest Lake, Minn.) won two key events this past weekend leading his team to a 163-135 win over conference rival Saint John's University. Kramer won the 200 freestyle in a season-best time of 1:46.05. He also took the 500 freestyle in a season-best time of 4:53.36, which is the fastest time recorded this year in the MIAC for that event.

January 21, 2003

Saint Mary's University first-year **Erik Oksnevad** (Blaine, Minn./Spring Lake Park HS) on Jan. 11 made national qualifying scores for the third time since he started his first season with SMU. Between two 1-meter events against St. Olaf he scored a total of 443.40 points. Most impressive dive was a Forward 2 ½ summersault in the tuck position with a degree of difficulty of 2.4. Judges scores were 8, 7.5, and 7.5. Oksnevad took first place in both events, contributing a total of 18 points for the team. He also participated on the cardinals B 200 Medley Relay at the meet.

January 14, 2003

Saint John's University senior **Jim Arnold** (St. Cloud, Minn.) opened the CSB/SJU Invitational Meet (January 10-11, 2003) by swimming an NCAA "B" time of 21.36 in the lead-off position in the 200 Free Relay which SJU won. Arnold later won the individual title in the 50 Free, winning with a time of 21.52. In the second day of competition, Arnold posted a winning time of 47.48 in the 100 Free helping his team to a second place finish in team competition.

December 9 2002

Gustavus Adolphus College sophomore **Will Sutor** (Fergus Falls, Minn.) dominated the University of Nebraska-Omaha Invitational recording three first-place finishes and one second-place finish against strong NCAA Division II competition. He set school records in the 100 butterfly (51.09), and the 200IM (1:56.79) and also achieved first-place finishes in the 50 free (21.49) and the 100 free (46.94).

November 26, 2002

Gustavus Adolphus College first-year **Brad Hammer** (Rock Island, IL) won all 3 events on Saturday against Saint Mary's. Hammer had season-best times in all three events, winning the 50 free with a time of 23.76. He also won the 100 breastroke with a time of 1:02.27. Hammer split a 27.7 on the winning 200 medley relay to finish the day.

November 19, 2002

Gustavus Adolphus College senior **Charlie Kimball** (Red Wing, Minn.) won both the 1-meter (263 points) and 3-meter (297 points) diving competitions against UW-Steven's Point on Saturday. His point total of 297 in the 3-meter event is a national-qualifying score.

November 12, 2002

Carleton College senior **Jason Brown** (Madison, Wis. / James Madison Memorial) turned in two strong weekend performances. In a span of 2 meets, Brown won 5 individual events and was part of 2 relays that posted season best times for the Knights. On Friday, Nov. 8, in a dual meet against host St. Thomas, Brown won both the 50 and 100 freestyles. On Saturday during the double-dual with host team St. John's and visiting Hamline, he continued his winning streak, posting season best times in the 200 free (1:48.40), the 50 free (21.59) and the 100 free (47.29).
