

John Knapp, Carleton

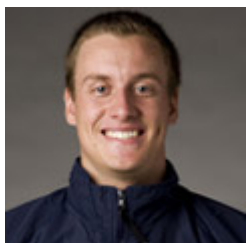

Ted Marschall, Carleton

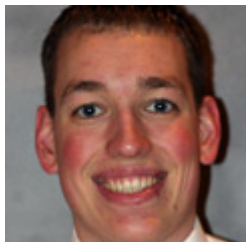

Carleton College senior **Ted Marschall** (Burnsville, Minn.) won three individual events and aided in a relay victory in a dual meet at Gustavus. The winning 200 Medley Relay time of 1:37.44 was a season best for the Knights. Marschall then won the 200 freestyle with a season-best time of 1:45.53. One event later, he won the 100 breaststroke in 1:01.50. Marschall concluded the meet with another victory in the 200 breaststroke, where he narrowly missed recording an NCAA "B" cut time after winning in 2:08.26, his best time of the year.

Skylar Davis, Gustavus

Gustavus Adolphus College junior **Skylar Davis** (Palatine, Ill.) recorded three first place finishes and one second at the Get to the Point Invite over the weekend in Stevens Point, Wis. Davis won the 1650 freestyle in a time of 16:38.52 and the 400 IM in 4:19.42. He was also a member of the winning 800 freestyle relay team that finished in 7:08.95. Davis added a second place finish in the 500 freestyle, finishing in 4:46.91 just behind teammate Matt Stewart.

Andrew Spratt, St. Thomas

University of St. Thomas sophomore **Andrew Spratt** (Centennial, Colo./East Crest) was among several Tommie standouts as he swept the 1650 freestyle (17:44.44) and 500 freestyle (4:58.78) races at the Saint Mary's Invite on Saturday in Winona, Minn. Both times were the best of the season for Spratt. St. Thomas won 11 events and placed first in the team portion of the invite.

Billy Schultze, Gustavus

Gustavus Adolphus College first-year **Billy Schultze** (Mankato, Minn./East) won three events at this past weekend's Saint John's Winter Invite on Saturday. Schultze posted a season-best time of 1:01.94 in winning the 100 breaststroke. He also won the 200 breaststroke with a time of 2:17.82. Schultze was a member of the 200 Medley Relay team that finished in a time of 1:38.12 to win the event.

Nathan Young, Macalester

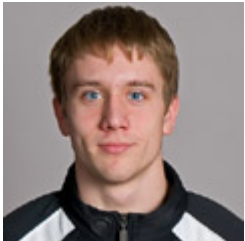

He started off winning the 100 backstroke in 53.10, then came back 10 minutes later to touch the wall first in the 50 free at 22.30 and finished off the day by winning the 200 backstroke in a seasonal best time of 1:58.50.

Erik Huls, St. Thomas

University of St. Thomas first-year **Erik Huls** (Farmington, Minn.) had a part in three wins in the St. Thomas/Saint John's Dual on Saturday. Huls won the 50 Freestyle (23.05), the 100 Butterfly (54.59), and swam a strong butterfly leg in the 400 Medley Relay. He is ranked among the top in the MIAC in all three of those events.

Nelson Westby, St. Olaf

St. Olaf College senior **Nelson Westby** (Salem, Ore./West Salem) won or was a part of five winning swims this past weekend at the Carthage Invitational in Kenosha, Wis. In three individual events, Westby had three "A" cuts for the national championships. His 100 breaststroke time of 54.66 was .17 seconds off the Division III record. His 200 breaststroke time of 1:58.98 was only .08 seconds off the

national record. The two breaststroke races and the 200 IM swim (1:50.86) are the top times in Division III this season. Both medley relays that Westby was a part of had strong "B" cut times. His 53.92 breaststroke split in the 400 MR made him the first swimmer in Division III to go under 54 seconds.

Peter Mullee, St. Thomas

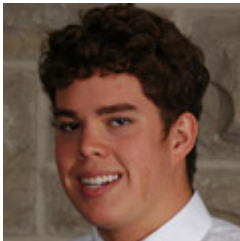

University of St. Thomas junior **Peter Mullee** (Madison, Wis./Memorial) won three events at the Macalester Invitational on Saturday. He won the 100 backstroke and his time of 50.89 broke the meet, pool and school records. The time would also have qualified Mullee fifth at last year's NCAA Championship meet. He won the 200 backstroke with a time of 2:01.08 and anchored the winning 400 freestyle relay which also broke the meet record (3:20.42). As a team, St. Thomas beat three other teams as they rolled up 567 and topped closest pursuer Saint Mary's (265).

Chris Bateman, St. Olaf

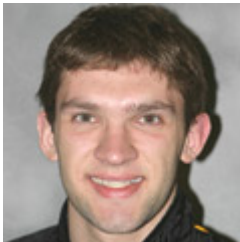

St. Olaf College sophomore **Chris Bateman** (Naperville, Ill.) played a big role in the Oles defeat of Gustavus (181-119) on Saturday. Bateman won the 500 freestyle with a time of 4:41.90 and the 200 IM finishing with a 1:59.18. He also placed second in the 100 breaststroke with a 1:00.82. He added a 27.92 split in the 50 breaststroke of the medley relay.

Matt Stewart, Gustavus

Gustavus Adolphus College senior **Matt Stewart** (Apple Valley, Minn.) won two events in a meet against MSU-Mankato on Friday, November 7. Stewart won the 200 freestyle with a time of 1:44.25 which is one tenth of a second off the Lund Natatorium pool record. He also took the 100 butterfly with a fast time of 51.41.
