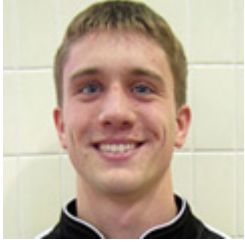


Erik Huls, St. Thomas

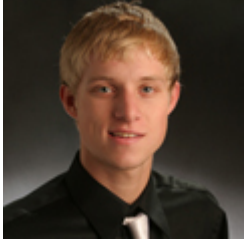
Farmington, Minn. / Farmington

University of St. Thomas sophomore **Erik Huls** (Farmington, Minn.) had a terrific meet for the Tommies at the Minnesota Challenge over the weekend at the University of Minnesota Aquatic Center. On Saturday, Huls was the top MIAC finisher in the 100 butterfly (51.94) and had a 49.39 split on the 400 freestyle relay team that was the top MIAC-placing team. Huls also swam a 51.48 split on the first-place 400 medley relay team, a 22.64 split for the third-place 200 medley relay team, and a 21.34 split on the 200 freestyle relay that placed fourth. Individually, Huls added strong performances in the 50 freestyle (21.80) and the 100 freestyle (48.79).

Wes Schlichting, Saint John's

Saint John's University sophomore **Wes Schlichting** (Sauk Rapids, Minn./Sauk Rapids-Rice) won both diving events posting a 454.55 in the 1-meter and a 439.90 in the 3-meter during the Johnnies' victorious two-day dual meet with Macalester on Friday and Saturday in St. Paul. In his final competition before the MIAC Championships, Schlichting scored national provisional marks on both boards.

Eric Brenner, Carleton

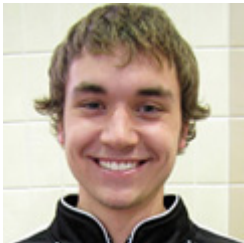
Plymouth, Minn. / Robbinsdale Armstrong

Carleton College junior **Eric Brenner** (Plymouth, Minn./Robbinsdale Armstrong) won both the 1- and 3-meter diving competitions (6-dives on each board) at the Carleton Mini-Invite on Saturday. His afternoon included a NCAA qualifying score of 287.90 off the higher board, highlighting several strong performances for the men's swimming and diving team. Brenner's scores in both events mark season bests for him and his 3-meter score is the top score in the MIAC for 6-dive competition.

Sam Rauchwarter, St. Thomas

University of St. Thomas first-year **Sam Rauchwarter** (Eagan, Minn./Eastview) recorded four personal best times at the St. Olaf Triple Dual over the weekend. In the 500 freestyle, Rauchwarter was the meet's top overall finisher with a time of 4:53.93. He added two second place finishes as well. In the 200 freestyle, Rauchwarter finished in 1:44.81 for the top time vs. St. Olaf and second fastest time overall. In the 50 freestyle, the first-year swimmer placed second behind All-American teammate Peter Mullee with a time of 22:33. Rauchwarter also swam a 21:45 split in the 200 freestyle relay.

Ian Straehley, St. Olaf

St. Olaf College sophomore **Ian Straehley** (Bismarck, N.D.) recorded a NCAA-qualifying 11-dive score at 1-meter during the Oles meet with Macalester on Saturday. Straehley placed first in the 1-meter as he recorded a 443.10 in the dual meet. Straehley is a returning Honorable Mention All-American diver. St. Olaf won the dual meet 108-57 over the Scots.

Ty Nimens, Saint John's

Saint John's University sophomore **Ty Nimens** (Crookston, Minn.) recorded a win in the 200 freestyle and three second-place finishes in the the Johnnies' dual meet with St. Thomas on Saturday. Nimens won the 200 freestyle in a time of 1:46.07. He also placed second in the 100 freestyle (48.67), the 100 butterfly (54.09) and he helped the SJU 200 medley relay team to a second place showing with his 23.73 butterfly split.

Chris Bateman, St. Olaf

St. Olaf College junior **Chris Bateman** (Naperville, Ill.) won three individual events and was a part of three winning relays at the Carthage College Invitational this past weekend. Bateman swam to NCAA 'A' cuts in both the 200 Back (1:50.44) and 400 IM (3:59.41) and a 'B' cut in the 500 Free (4:32.29).

Peter Mullee, St. Thomas

Madison, Wis. / Memorial

University of St. Thomas senior **Peter Mullee** (Madison, Wis./Memorial) won all three events he competed in on Saturday at Macalester's Roger Ahlman Invitational. Mullee won the 50 free (21.29), the 100 back (51.49), and led off the winning 400 free relay with a 46.68 in the first 100 yards. His time in the 100 back was also a national "B" cut time. The 400 free relay's winning time of 3:12.19 was also a meet record. All three of Mullee's times from Saturday are currently #1 in the MIAC. St. Thomas won the team title in the five-team event.

Brock Edwards, St. Olaf

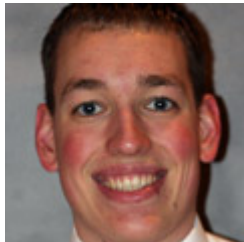
Alexandria, Minn. / Alexandria

St. Olaf College senior **Brock Edwards** (Alexandria, Minn.) had four first place finishes in helping lead the Oles to a team victory over Gustavus on Saturday. Edwards anchored the Oles' 200 Medley Relay with a split of 21.13, led off the 400 freestyle relay with a time of 47.90, and won both the 50 freestyle (22.14) and 100 freestyle (48.07) races.

Skylar Davis, Gustavus

Palatine, Ill. / Palatine

Gustavus Adolphus College senior **Skylar Davis** (Palatine, Ill.) broke the 500-yard freestyle pool record at MSU-Mankato on Friday night (4:46.43) and then went even faster on Saturday (4:45.52) at home versus St. Cloud State. Davis won both races. He added a 200-yard freestyle win (1:46.38) on Friday and a 1,000-yard freestyle win (9:53.48) on Saturday. Davis also had key second-place performances in the 200IM and the lead-off leg of the 400-yard relay in back-to-back races during the Gusties win over St. Cloud State.
