1959-60 MIAC Men's Swimming & Diving Championships - Recap

Five new MIAC records were established as Gustavus Adolphus won an unprecedented fifth consecutive championship.

The stars of the meet were Macalester's Hugh Wooldridge and John Bennett, who were responsible for the five new records set during the meet. Senior Wooldridge set new marks in the 200 butterfly and the 160 individual medley and was a member of the record breaking medley relay team. Bennett, a junior, set records in the two breaststroke races and was also a member of the medley relay team.

Double winners were John Spilane of St. Thomas with wins in the 220 and 1500 freestyle races, and Don Pederson of Hamline in the two backstroke races.

Freshman Phil Benson was high point man for the champion Gustavus team by virtue of his first and seconds in the longer freestyle races.
