If teams are still tied, then record against the #11 team will be considered and so on until the tie is broken).
- 4. Coin flip.

If a game(s) is halted, it should be continued at the spot where it was halted as per the NCAA rule book concerning halted games. All tournament games need to be completed by the NCAA deadline for NCAA tournament selection.
