MIAC Women's Basketball Playoff Seeding Tie Breakers

- 1. Head to head competition winning percentage * against all teams tied.
- 2. Combined winning percentage* against all teams above those tied.
- 3. Winning percentage* against above teams beginning in rank order^.
- 4. Winning percentage* against teams below tied teams in descending order^.
- 5. Best road winning percentage*.
- 6. Coin flip.

*Winning percentage: When comparing records against a single team or a group of teams, the higher winning percentage shall prevail, even if the number of games played against the team or group are unequal. (Example: 2-0 is better than 3-1, but 2-0 is not better than 1-0).

^Rank order comparison: When arriving at another pair of tied teams while comparing records, use each team's record against the collective tied teams as a group (prior to their own tie-breaking procedure), rather than the performance against the individual tied teams. (Example: Team A and Team B tie for fourth place. Team C and Team D tie for second place. The Team C-D tiebreaker is settled first using tiebreaker criteria. If the Team A-B tiebreaker reaches the second-place team(s) in Criteria No. 3, Team A and Bs record will be compared collectively against Teams C and D, not individually against the winner of the C-D tiebreaker first.)
