
## MIAC hockey teams return to the ice this weekend



**BLOOMINGTON, Minn.** – For the first time since last March, Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAC) hockey teams are poised to be back on the ice in a competitive setting.

Both the MIAC men's and women's hockey schedules will feature eight teams in conference competition this winter. Squads from Augsburg, Bethel, Concordia, Gustavus, Hamline, Saint Benedict/Saint John's, Saint Mary's, and St. Thomas will participate in a seven-game conference slate, set to begin on Saturday, February 6. Teams are also permitted to play up to four nonconference contests, with games getting underway as early as this Friday, January 29.
