

# 1998 MIAC Women's Outdoor Track & Field Awards

**Erica Stone** of Gustavus was selected Women's MIAC Outdoor Track and Field Most Outstanding Athlete (33 voting points) for her performance at the outdoor championship May 8-9, 1998.

Stone won the 200 meter dash in MIAC record time and automatically qualified for the national championships at Macalester. She also finished second in the 100 and ran on Gustavus' 400 and 1600 relays which both finished first and qualified automatically for nationals.

Also receiving top votes were **Jayna Mathieu** of St. Olaf (32), who won the 800 and 1500 and also ran on St. Olaf's winning 3200 relay and third-place 1600 relay, and **Astrid Larssen** of Augsburg (17) who won the 100 in meet record time and finished second in the 200. Larssen's effort in the 100 was selected Most Outstanding Performance of the meet.
