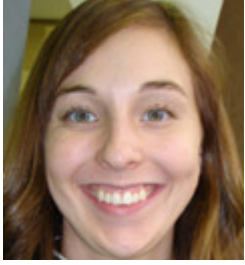


Becca Ney, St. Thomas

Carrie Gundersen, Gustavus

Gustavus Adolphus College sophomore **Carrie Gundersen** (Minnetonka, Minn./Hopkins) posted four first places in leading Gustavus to a 152-148 win over St. Olaf Friday night, November 9th. Gundersen won the 1000 free with a MIAC-best time of 10:55.63. She also picked up wins in the 500 free (5:24.02) and the 100 free (56.26). Having to win the last event, the 400 free relay, Gundersen anchored the relay to victory and a time of 3:45.09.

Erica Campbell, St. Catherine

College of St. Catherine senior **Erica Campbell** (Baxter, Minn.) won both of her individual events this past weekend and was a member of the winning 200-yard Medley Relay against Augsburg College and University of Minnesota-Morris.
