Tiebreakers

1. Head-to-head record (if there are more than two teams, then overall record against the tied teams will be used)
2. Total singles and doubles matches won against tied teams, so if there are three tied teams and the results are as follows:
 - Team A defeated Team B: 7-0
 - Team B defeated Team C: 4-3
 - Team C defeated Team A: 6-1Team A would be the higher seed with 9 matches won, Team A would be second with 8 matches won and Team B would be third with 4 matches won.
Note: Doubles counted as one match for tiebreaking purposes in seven-point format.
3. Record against teams above tied teams.
4. Total individual singles and doubles matches won against all teams above tied teams (doubles counted as one match).
5. Total individual singles and doubles matches won in all MIAC play (doubles counted as one match).
6. Coin flip.

*After an order is selected using the tie breaking procedure, if teams remain tied then all remaining tied teams will revert to the beginning of the tie breaking procedure. If at any point one of the tiebreaker criteria separates one or more of the teams involved in the multiple-team tie, said teams will be separated out, and any remaining teams will return to criteria No. 1.
